Quorem at this meeting of the Society shall be 25 members in good standing (s.14 of existing bylaw). Each individual who has been a member in good standing\* for three months shall be entitled to one vote at all membership meetings. A Family Membership entitles two members of the family to vote if both are present at a membership meeting, but there shall be no proxy voting. Those who have not been members in good standing for three months prior to a membership meeting shall not have a vote at that meeting (s. 15).

BCCLA By-laws may be amended at any annual general membership meeting by a two-thirds majority vote of those members in attendance, upon at least fourteen days' written notice to the membership of the proposed amendments (s.20).
